1 Heard the learned senior counsel appearing for the review petitioners. The fact that the delay condonation application made by the petitioners is allowed by the Appellate Authority is no ground for review. This Court has held that the structure/bungalow which is ordered to be demolished has been illegally and unauthorisedly constructed. No case is made out for review. Review petition is rejected.

2 The learned senior counsel appearing for the review petitioners seeks extension of time granted to the authorities to demolish the structure/bungalow. As there is no merit in the review petition such extension cannot be granted.
